

# ELECTION OF 2012-2013 NATIONAL DELEGATES

This year the membership-at-large will once again elect the National delegates who will assist in the governance of our association. Whatever you do, don't take anything for granted. Current Delegates WILL NOT AUTOMATICALLY appear on the ballot as a candidate. Everyone who is to be considered for election must appear on the ballot as a nominated candidate or as a write-in candidate. We want every state to have the full voting power to which it is entitled, so check the chart to see how many delegates your state is eligible to elect. Every member of every state should share the responsibility of nominating enough potential National Delegates to fill all the allotted slots and for urging all other members to cast a vote in the election.

This is such an important matter that we hope you will pay special attention to the requirements for an eligible nomination and election. First and foremost, the nominee and all five of the endorsers must be current members of the association and all must live in the state that the nominee will represent. Secondly, the person being nominated must have shot a minimum of 500 registered targets during the year prior to the election year (2010) and 500 registered targets during the election year (2011). All nomination forms must be received between July 1 and July 21. Faxed nominations will be accepted. Nomination forms must include all required information. Remember! A valid nomination form must include the signatures of five current

members, with their membership numbers included, the candidate's signature and NSCA number on the same form. Ballots will be sent to all current members of each state on August 1, 2011.

Nomination is only the beginning of the procedure! In order to be elected, candidates must receive at least five votes from current members living in their state. To be considered valid, ballots must be received at headquarters no later than 5p.m., August 22, 2011. Votes will be tabulated as quickly as possible (remember, a candidate must receive five votes for his/her election to be valid) and elected delegates will be notified. Results will be printed in the next available issue of Sporting Clays Magazine and posted on [www.nssa-nsca.org](http://www.nssa-nsca.org). Ballots for run-off elections, when necessary due to tied votes, will be sent out immediately after balloting is completed.

A Nomination Form is included as part of this month's Headlines from Headquarters. You may cut out or copy this form if you would like to submit yourself or someone else as a candidate or you can call Glynne Moseley at 210-254-1523 for a copy. The Nomination Form will not be mailed to each individual member. One more point to remember - If you are nominating another person as a National Delegate, you must include that person's signature, on the nomination form, as the candidate willing to accept the responsibilities for the position.
